

**FOR PROFESSIONAL USE ONLY**

Safely and quickly removes inks, marking pens, stencil, wood pitch/resin, paint marks (spray-latex-enamel), lipstick, and crayon. Caution: Harmful or fatal if swallowed. If swallowed, DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Call a physician immediately. Avoid prolonged skin contact. Wash skin thoroughly with water after contact to avoid irritation and skin drying. If irritation occurs, apply skin lotion or petroleum jelly. Avoid eye contact. In case of eye contact, flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. Call a physician if irritation persists. Use with adequate ventilation.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For carpet and upholstery: Always treat stains or spills immediately or as soon as possible to obtain best removal.

1. For spills remove excess liquid by blotting with clean white absorbent towel or by scraping off excess with a dull knife or spatula.
2. Before using a spotter, test on inconspicuous area of the carpet or fabric for effects on color. If no discoloration or color bleeding occurs, then proceed with removal.
3. Do not wet or rinse area to be cleaned prior to application of spotter.
4. Work spotter into spot or stain. Blot up any excess, then rinse with water followed by blotting. Repeat rinse or application of spotter as necessary to remove spot.

**-SPECIFIC SPOT REMOVAL DIRECTIONS-**

**Ink, Marker, Stencil - Very effective.** On some inks minimal removal may seem to occur initially. However, adequately work I-M-R into stain, then apply water, work area, blot. Color should appear on the blotting material. Repeat steps as needed. More than one application may be necessary.

**Wood Pitch/Resin - Sometimes this can be a layer by layer removal.** Apply and agitate spot, wait a few seconds, then agitate again. Blot and re-apply as necessary. When pitch appears to be removed, blot up excess. Then, apply a water rinse, blot and repeat rinse as needed. More than one application may be necessary.

**Paint - Depending on how long this has dried the spot may behave like ink and remove quickly or upon long drying may behave like pitch and remove a layer at a time.**

**Crayon/Lipstick - These can be removed completely depending on the color. Red may leave a faint color trace.**
